Lawn Stencil and Painting Instructions:



Congratulations on your purchase of your Turf Tattooz custom lawn stencil. Before you begin, make sure your grass area is freshly cut and free of leaves and other debris. A dry day with little or no wind is ideal for lawn painting.

Make sure you have the proper colors and quantity of turf paint to complete this art:

6-pack - 3 cans red, 2 white and 1 black.

For season-long good looks and touch up - get the 12 pack - 6 cans of red, 4 white and 2 black.

Position the stencil using the centering dots.

- 1.) Secure stencil to grass, long nails or cut coat hangers work fine.
- 2.) Mark the dots cut in the stencil with Red aerosol turf paint.
- 3.) Remove stencil and begin painting.



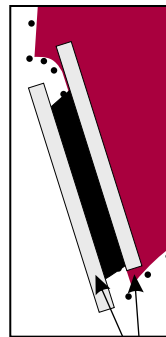
Painting Tips:

Use these color photos as a guide for painting.

Place a Turf Tattooz Lining Board at the edge of the dots for cleaner looking straight lines.

Outline the Red with black as shown on photo.

Fold the stencil (make sure it is DRY) and store for future use.

Enjoy and have some fun! The painted area can be mowed and the logo "touched up" as needed with extra paint throughout the season.
